

CORRECTION: This article states regarding the Socialist Party, ' They joined the Irish Anti-War Movement only after the massive mobilisation on 2003 and then left afterwards'. This is an error. As Michael O'Brien has pointed out, he joined the Steering Committee of the IAWM, on behalf of the SP, in September 2002 and served until the SP withdrew in 2006, and moreover he was Chief Steward on the 2003 demonstration. I apologise for this mistake. But, of course, I still stand over the general argument of the article including the part about the weakness of the SP on questions of anti-imperialism.
